



HUNTER SCHOOLING SHOW SUPPLY LIST

Hay net/bag filled with hay
Trailer Wraps * + (for tail and/or legs)
Head bumper* +
Shaped Fleece saddle pad (White only, must match size of saddle)
Wind pants and/or large T-shirt to cover show cloths while grooming/tacking
Garters (riders in paddock boots) that match boots
Belts for Breeches/jodpurs that match boots
Carrots/Treats
One Large Bucket (for water for your horse)
Crop (no Dressage whips!)
Stud Chain (To hang the bucket for water)
Saddle w/ girth, leathers, stirrups (stirrups must have clean pads)
Body Brush
Black Gloves (leather preferred, please note.. Gloves are NOT OPTIONAL)
Face Brush
Tie Back or Show Bow for Rider's Hair (or for riders under the age of 13, bows for braids on child)
Mane/Tail Brush
Bridle w/ Bit & Reins (no running martingales at Hunter/Jumper shows)
Hoof Pick
Halter and Lead Rope
Black Velvet Helmet or Helmet w/Black velvet cover
Show Sheen or similar silicone body spray (for horse)
Talcum Powder*
Fly Spray*
Chairs*
Negative Coggins Test
Horse Cooler (winter only)
Sweat Scraper
Sunscreen
Umbrella and/or Rain Gear*
Saddle Rack
Snackies
Old Towels (2-4)
Saddle Soap and Sponge/rags for Cleaning Tack (Lexol wipes for leather are highly recommended)
Ice Chest and/or water bottle
White or pastel show shirt (Long sleeves preferable, short okay)
Embroidered rat catcher collar (w/ rider's initials in dark lettering to match jacket)
Field Boots (tall boots) in black for riders over age 13, paddock boots (black or brown) for under age 13
Hair net (NOT the same as a 'show bow!')
Tall socks if wearing tall boots
Camera and/or video camera*
Small portable tack trunk or grooming kit
Horse shampoo

	Black or navy show jacket, hunter cut for jumping (gray or dark green are okay for hunter shows, but black and navy are the only colors acceptable for dressage, so black or navy does 'double duty' and can be worn at any show, whether it's hunters, jumpers, combined training, eventing or dressage.)
	Breeches or jodpurs in light gray, tan, or khaki (NO dark colors accepted, and under age 13 must wear Jodpurs w/ cuffs and elastic hold-downs. It is recommended that riders bring an extra pair, too)
